	Morning Supervision
	 Change: We take supervision of your children very seriously! With this in mind, we have made some changes to our morning routines. Supervisors will be on duty at 8:25 AM. All students are to play or socialize outside until 8:37 AM. At that time, their teachers will let them into the school at their designated doors. On inclement days, students may enter the school through the front doors and proceed to their classrooms.
	For the safety of students please do not send students to school <u>before supervision begins at 8:25.</u>
Green/Dot Inside Please	Inclement Weather When at all possible, we give students opportunity to play and socialize outside. However, there are some times when this is not possible. During inclement weather, students will be supervised inside during breaks and a Green Dot will be posted on our doors. The green dot indicates that students need to stay inside. When it is raining heavily or it is below -20 Celsius including wind chill, students will remain inside. Please dress your child for the weather as they will go outside if at all possible.
